PACKING CHECKLIST

2 years old

(# of items per baby)

Trip Approximately 1 week**

**assumes ability to do laundry if trip is longer

A) Clothes

- Fleece blankets (1 each)
- T-shirts (3 each)
 - 2 long-sleeve each
 - 2 short-sleeve each
- Daytime clothes (*be prepared for both types of weather with skew towards local forecast*)
 - warm weather (*pants/shirts/dress*)
 - cooler weather (*pants/shirts/dress*)
- PJs (2 each)
- Underwear (7-9 each, if potty trained)
- Fleece pants and shirt (1 set each)
- Jacket/Sweatshirt (1 each)
- Socks (3 pairs each)
- Shoes (1 pair each)
- Sandals (1 pair each if going to warm weather)
- Swimsuit (1 each or 2 if going to warm weather or if pool at hotel)
- Hats
 - Wool/Fleece (1 each if going to cold weather)
 - Sunhats (1 each if going to warm weather)
- Gloves, if going to cold weather (1 pair each)

B) Toys/Gadgets

- CARES safety harness for plane (kidsflysafe.com) (1 each)
- Books (3 each)
- Toys (finger puppet book, Brain Quest, another small toy each)
- Small bag of large Leggos, doubles as bath toys
- Stuffed animal (1 for each)
- iPod / iPhone
 - iPod / iPhone
 - connectors for stereo or portable speakers
 - car connector

- charger (if no car connector or other charging capabilities)
 - Camera with charger and USB cord for downloading if have computer, otherwise extra chip space
 - Video camera with charger
 - DVD player
 - DVDs (3-4 each)
 - Power plug and car connector
- C) Feeding Time
- Lightweight medium-size “disposable” bowls with lids (1 for singleton, 2 total for twins)
 - Lightweight small “disposable” snack bowls with lids (for cherrios) (1 for singleton, 2 total for twins)
 - Lightweight “disposable” spoons (2 total for singleton, 3 for twins)
 - Sippy cups (1 for singleton, 2 for twins, lightweight “disposable” sippy cups)
 - Travel bottle of dishwashing soap
- D) Bath Time
- Little hairbrush
 - Barretts and pony tail holders
 - Toothbrush
 - Toothpaste, travel size
 - First aid kit (see separate list)
 - Travel bottles with:
 - Shampoo
 - Baby wash
- E) First Aid Travel Kit (know weight of child before leaving or most recent weight/date at last doctor’s visit)
- Mylecon
 - Infant Tylenol and/or Motrin (or generic brand)
 - Aquaphor lotion travel size
 - Thermometer
 - Nail clippers
 - Band-Aids
 - Little CPR booklet
 - First Aid/Child Safety sheet (from Baby CPR/First Aid class)
 - Sunscreen (45 spf, for babies)
 - Alcohol pads
 - Disinfectant wipes
 - Vaseline travel size
 - Neosporin

F) **To bring on plane** (includes items from packing list above, pack in large travel bag; tip: organize and tell spouse where everything is in bag beforehand. If traveling with twins, have two bags packed, one for you and one baby and another for your spouse and second baby)

- Snack bowl with cherrios with lid (1 each)
- Water bottle (already filled, if have to dump at security, buy new water near gate)
- Wipes (lots, enough for potential messes and potential delays)
- Diapers / Pull-Ups (10 for each baby, more for long flights; enough for potential messes and potential delays; tip: put in zip-lock bag so won't get wet. If toddler is in underwear already, still bring pull-ups, recommended to wear on plane even if potty trained or in process of being potty trained)
- Noiseless toys (soft cover books, crayons and coloring book, puppet book)
- CARES harness (1 for singleton, 2 for twins)
- Blankets (fleece) (have with car seats)
- Extra clothes for baby
 - 1 lightweight pull up pairs of pants each
 - 1 extra shirt each
 - Light-weight fleece pants and shirt (1 set each)
 - Pair of socks (1 pair each)
- Extra clothes for mom and dad (extra shirt for each)
- Car seats (with either car seat bags or go-go Kidz)
- Stroller (to gate check)
- Passports (if traveling international)

G) Things to buy/have at destination

- Diapers / Pull-Ups (buy, arrange to have been bought beforehand if possible)
- Swimmer diapers (if going to go to pool/beach)
- Wipes (buy, arrange to have been bought beforehand if possible)
- Food (yogurt, mac 'n cheese, milk, soup, crackers)
- Pack & Play (1 for each)
